Teaching learning process

- A) With reference to the institutional academic calendar, all departments have carried out academic activities including project reviews, conduction of CIE test etc.
- B) Teaching learning activity monitoring is done by HOD and PAC members as per guidelines.
- C) Syllabus coverage in all the courses was almost 100% in all the departments.
- D) Quality of CIE question papers, scheme of evaluations were as per standards.
- E) Evaluation of CIE test was done as per the scheme of evaluation.
- F) In all laboratory classes, student's performance evaluation is done as per laid down procedure.
- G) Extra classes are conducted for weak students in all the departments after institution is allowed to conduct offline classes.
- H) Feedbacks from students on Teaching Learning process and faculty performance were collected and it is found that by large students are satisfied with Teaching Learning process and performance of faculty.
- I) Total 511 Students have enrolled in MOOCs and NPTEL courses.

Since there were no topics to discuss, the meeting was concluded with the permission of the chair.

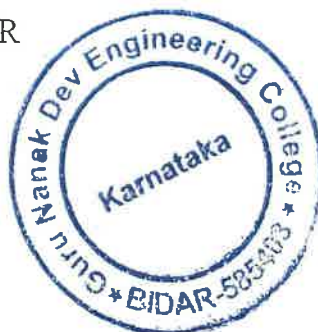
