# Agenda No. 7. Open Electives for 6<sup>th</sup> semester students of 2018 scheme:

Dean Academics, Dr. Sindhu S, conveyed to the council that, in accordance with VTU guidelines, students of the 2018 scheme are required to choose one open elective in the sixth semester from a specified list. It is a condition that students opt for an open elective offered by the board of studies in a discipline other than their own. Dr. Sindhu S further urged all Heads of Departments (HODs) to appoint an open elective coordinator who will brief students on the VTU guidelines. Additionally, HODs are requested to identify faculty members capable of handling these electives. Dr. Anoop Elia suggested a special emphasis on educating students, particularly those in Mechanical Engineering and Civil Engineering disciplines, to consider open electives from the Computer Science board of studies. This strategic choice aims to enhance the chances of students from these disciplines securing placements in software companies.

#### Agenda No. 8. Participation of faculty/staff in FDP:

The principal has made a proactive decision to encourage the adoption of NPTEL courses among both faculty and students. All departments are urged to prioritize the participation of a maximum number of faculty and staff in development programs while ensuring minimal disruption to ongoing academic activities. Furthermore, faculty and staff are encouraged to register on the 'ARPRIT' portal for FDP/SDP online programs, expanding their opportunities for professional growth.
