

#### LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the test or the later seat selection process and admission is subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High court of Karnataka. The issue of admission order by the KEA shall enable the candidate to join the concerned college, subject to the academic eligibility, etc., being approved by the concerned University as per the Regulations.

#### APPEAL

Any person aggrieved by the order or decision of the Executive Director under CET-2006 Rules may within 15 days from the date of such order or decision, appeal to the Principal Secretary to Government, Education Department (Higher Education), Government of Karnataka, who after calling for records from the Executive Director and after examining the same, shall pass orders as he / she deems fit, which shall be final.

#### SEAT CANCELLATION, FORFEITURE and FIVE TIMES PENALTY

As per rule 12 of sub-rule (5) of CET-2006 rules, if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in any discipline in an Engineering College or Institution, surrenders the seat after completion of respective Casual Vacancy Round, the Executive Director shall forfeit the entire fee paid and the candidate shall be liable to pay a penalty of FIVE times of the fee. Please read "A NOTE ON SEAT CANCELLATION, REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEE" given in this bulletin with regard to cancellation and forfeiture clause.

#### BEWARE OF TOUTS, BROKERS OR MIDDLEMEN

Few persons may approach you saying they have known people in KEA who guarantee Engineering / Architecture / Farm Science / Veterinary / Medical / Dental etc seats through unfair means during counseling. Counseling for all courses are conducted and distributed as per the calendar of events in the ambit of the State Government rules as per UGCET / UGNEET merit score and option entry exercised by the candidate. Hence, candidates and parents should not trust any persons. In case you have any information regarding such persons please intimate immediately to KEA e-mail.

#### SUPERNUMBERARY QUOTA:

5% of the seats in each college and in each course will be reserved as Supernumerary Quota (SNQ) in all Engineering Colleges. This quota is over and above the seat matrix issued by the Government. The tuition fee prescribed by the Government in that particular college will be waived off. The candidate has to pay University / other fees only. This Supernumerary quota is not available in for Architecture Course. All poor and meritorious candidates including General Merit are eligible for allotment of seats under Supernumerary quota (Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme) whose annual income of the family from all the sources is less than Rs.8.00 Lakhs. All the eligible candidates whose income is less than Rs.8.00 Lakhs, should obtain income certificate from the concerned Tahasildar and enter the RD number of the income certificate to become eligible for Supernumerary Quota (SNQ).

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#### WHAT IS NEW IN THIS YEAR?

- Information with regard to caste, income and 371(j) will be verified through Web-service based on the Caste / Caste Income Certificate RD Number and 371(j) RD number entered by the candidate in the online application form. Candidate has to enter the correct RD number carefully in the online application. In case, the RD detail does not match with the data, schedule will be given in the month of June 2023 to appear for physical verification.
- SC, ST and Cat-1 candidates should obtain income certificate and enter the RD number of the income certificate carefully, to avail the benefit of fee exemption.
- General Merit candidates if their annual income is below Rs.8.00 Lakhs, then obtain income
  certificate from the concerned Tahasildar and enter the RD number of the income certificate
  carefully, to claim Supernumerary Quota (SNQ).
- Candidate name, father name, mother name and date of birth will be obtained from Karnataka SSLC board based on the SSLC register number through SATS. Therefore, candidates who have passed SSLC from Karnataka have to enter their correct SSLC register number in the online application form.
- Online application tracking system will be enabled; candidates can track the status of their online application.
- The Government in its Order No. ಹಿಂಪಕ 304 ಬಿಸಿಎ 2017 ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು, ದಿನಾಂಕ 14–09–2018. has enhanced the annual income limit from `6.00 Lakhs to `8.0' Lakhs per annum for claiming reservation benefit. The candidate and his / her father's mother's who's Gross Annual Income is below Rs.8.00 Lakhs are eligible to claim benefit of reservation under 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B categories.

### NOT-ELIGIBLE FOR CET-2023 - PREVIOUS YEAR SEAT ALLOTTED CANDIDATES

A candidate who had obtained a seat in any discipline through KEA (CET Cell) in any of the previous years and not surrendered the seat before the last date fixed for entry of options for final round of seat allotment for the respective disciplines will not be eligible for allotment of a seat to the same discipline during 2023 as per rule 15 (5) of CET-2006 Admission Rules. However, he / she is eligible to appear for CET-2023 for allotment of seat in any other discipline. Eg: If a candidate had selected Engineering seat during previous year, he / she will not be considered for allotment of seats in the same engineering discipline, however, he or she is eligible for selection of Medical / Dental / ISM&H / Architecture / Farm Science courses, B-Pharma / Pharma-D, if he / she is fulfilling the eligibility conditions. Further, the seat selected during the previous year gets automatically cancelled, upon selection of a seat in a different discipline during this year.

#### General Instructions

1. All candidates are directed to see the website of KEA <a href="http://kea.kar.nic.in">http://kea.kar.nic.in</a> atleast twice every day for updates. Likewise the instruction / information will also be sent to the mobile number furnished by the candidates in the online application form. KEA or the Government shall not be responsible for any action / consequence resulting due to non-diligent follow up of notices, notifications and publications appearing on the KEA website on CET-2023 by the Candidates.

- 2. The candidates must compulsorily verify their qualifying examination marks printed on the result sheets without fail, if there is any discrepancy with reference to qualifying examination marks, the same should be brought to the notice of this office immediately for assignment of new ranks, if necessary.
- 3. If the qualifying examination marks of the candidates change after revaluation or re-totaling then the candidates are required to submit a copy of the latest marks card indicating the change in marks if any to the KEA for assignment of revised / new rank.
- 4. All the candidates (GM, SC, ST Category I, 2A, 2B, 3A & 3B category candidates) must compulsorily produce the STUDY CERTIFICATE (wherever necessary) obtained from the head of the institution which should be countersigned by concerned Block Educational Officer (BEO) from where the candidate has passed the 10th standard / SSLC examination, by mentioning the Standards, Academic years, Mother Tongue as per the admission register of the institution. (as per format shown at page 43)
- 5. The candidates who claim seat under rural category will have to obtain a rural study certificate from the respective school / high school issued by the head of the institution which should be countersigned by concerned Block Educational Officer (BEO) as per format shown at page 51.
- 6. General merit candidates who claim seat in rural category should also submit Non Creamy Layer Certificate (NCLC) issued from the concerned Tahasildar along with the rural study certificate, as per format shown at page 51.
- 7. The candidates who have studied in the areas mentioned in Page 49-50 during their school days are not eligible to claim rural category seat. However, if the place where the candidate had studied from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> standard comes under rural area at the time of his / her studies, he / she will be eligible under rural quota, even though the same place has been declared as urban area in later days.
- 8. Candidates belonging to reserved categories should possess valid Caste / Caste Income Certificate as the case may be, issued by the Concerned Tahasildar in Form 'D' for SC, ST; Form 'E' for Category-I and Form 'F' for 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B categories, and Caste / Caste income certificate should be in the name of the candidate only. Further, they should have claimed their reservation in the application form; also enter the correct RD number without fail during entry of online application form.
- 9. Candidates claiming Kalyana-Karnataka Region Reservation (Article 371 (j)) must possess the certificate [Annexure A (eligibility certificate rule 3(3))] issued by the concerned Assistant Commissioner, and they should claim the reservation and also enter the correct RD number without fail during entry of online application form.
- 10. KEA will allot the seats ONLINE in the order of merit and based on the priority of options obtained from the candidates. Candidates have to enter the options of their choice on the specified URL at KEA Website on their own arrangements. Candidates will have the choice to enter as many numbers of options as they desire. Candidates may note that they should enter their options carefully by following the prescribed procedures.

#### **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ON OPTION ENTRY:**

The options entered by the candidate for the first round will remain same for all the rounds of seat allotment. The candidates will not be allowed to enter options again. Option Entry done before the first round will be the final list of options. The priority of options entered by the candidate will be shown on the option entry module by obtaining the candidate credentials. Candidate may delete or alter order of higher options. The candidate will be allowed to add new options for any colleges and course that came into the seat matrix after the first round.

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- 11. The candidate who has obtained a seat in any discipline through KEA (CET Cell) in any of the previous year's shall not be eligible to continue in the course to which he / she has been admitted during the previous years immediately upon selection of a seat in any different discipline during the current year.
- 12. A candidate may have option to select Medical / Engineering etc; seat in other boards like AICTE, AIIMS, COMED-K and KEA etc. In case such candidate wishes to confirm the seat selected from other boards then such candidate who has also been allotted a seat through KEA has to surrender the seat allotted by KEA before commencement of Second Extended Round of seat allotment, failing which it may amount to blocking of seat and Government may initiate both civil and criminal action against such candidates.
- 13. If a candidate decides to surrender the seat, he / she has to surrender the seat only to KEA in writing. Merely not reporting to the selected / allotted college should not be presumed by the candidate that he / she have surrendered the seat to KEA.
- 14. No requests for Mutual Transfer of seats will be entertained by KEA at any point of time.
- 15. All the admissions / allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to approval by the Government / concerned University / Apex Bodies.

(Hons) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons) Sericulture, B.Sc. (Hons) Horticulture, B.Sc (Hons) Forestry, B.Tech (Bio-Technology), B.Sc.(Hons) Community Science, B.Tech (Agricultural Engineering), B.Tech (Food Technology), B.Tech (D. Tech), B.F.Sc (Fisheries), B.Sc. (Hons) Agri. Business Management] B. Pharma, Pharma-D and 2nd year B-Pharma (Lateral Entry) course, in Government / University / Private Aided / Private Un-Aided Professional Educational Institutions in the State of Karnataka for the academic year 2023-24.
- 1.2 Admission to Government seats shall be made in accordance with the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government Seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules, 2006 (in short CET-2006 Admission Rules) as amended from time to time and therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders. In case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail.
- 1.3 The candidates who wish to seek admission to Medical or Dental or Ayurveda or Unani or Homoeopathy courses must compulsorily qualify in UGNEET-2023 (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) & subject to fulfilling the eligibility clauses of rule 5 of CET-2006 rules / Government relevant orders.
- 1.4 For admission to Architecture course candidate should compulsorily qualify in NATA -2023 conducted by the Council of Architecture. Visit www.nata.in and www.nata.nic.in.
- 1.5 As per the seat matrix issued by the Government, the seat allotment to the above mentioned courses will be done ONLINE in the order of merit / rank obtained in 2023 CET / NEET / NATA as applicable, and based on the options entered by the candidates through KEA Web-portal.
- 1.6 Only upon successful verification and possessing of verification slip, candidate will be allowed to enter the options. Candidates can enter any number of options of their choice through KEA Web-portal on their own arrangement. The candidate also has a provision to take a print out in each round. Every candidate shall be given high security user ID and Secret Key which the candidate then has to login and change it to password as per his / her choice.
- 1.7 Candidates are advised to verify and confirm that they are fulfilling any one of the Eligibility Clauses before applying for admission to Government seats in Professional Colleges in the state of Karnataka for the year 2023. For any reason the fee paid by the candidates will not be refunded.
- 1.8 The SC / ST/Category-I / 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B and other eligibility criteria is applicable to Karnataka candidates who are eligible to claim eligibility for Government seats under clauses (a), (b), (f), (h), (j), (k) (l) and (o) and the same is not applicable to eligibility clauses (c), (d), (e), (g), (i), (m) and (n) to claim Government Seats and Government quota seats as per proviso of rule 9 (2) of CET-2006 Admission Rules.
- 1.9 Reservation of seats in certain categories such as Rural, Kannada etc and in Special Categories like NCC, Sports etc are applicable only to Karnataka candidates who are eligible for Government seats and Government Quota seats (rule 5 of CET-2006 rules).
- 1.10 The information furnished by the candidate in the CET-2023 online application form with regard to Caste / Category and Annual Income remains the same for the purpose of assignment of ranks / selection or allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason. Hence the candidates are informed to enter the details correctly and exercise the options in the order of priority.
- 1.11 Any application not in compliance with the conditions specified in the information bulletin is liable to be rejected.

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#### 2. DISCLAIMER

- 2.1 The responsibility of KEA is limited to the conduct of counseling, which includes online registration, document verification, online counseling procedure, seat allotment and issue of admission order as per Government Rules

- 2.7 KEA does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be purely provisional subject to fulfillment of academic and other eligibility criteria prescribed by the State / Universities / Institutions / Deemed Universities concerned.
- 2.8 All the admissions / allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to approval by the Government / concerned University / Apex Bodies.
- 2.9 If the information furnished by the candidates in the application form or any other document/s submitted by the candidates / parents are found to be false / incorrect / tampered / forged such candidate's seat will be cancelled at any point of time during his / her course of study and criminal proceedings as per rules will be initiated by KEA as provided under rule 13 of CET-2006 Admission Rules against the candidate.

Candidates who have passed or are appearing for Qualifying Examination within Karnataka should write 'CET-2023' in a test centre assigned by the KEA within the district in which the candidate has studied 2nd PUC or 12th standard.

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• KANNADA LANGUAGE TEST: The candidates claiming eligibility for Government seats under Horanadu & Gadinadu Kannadiga clauses and whose mother tongue is Kannada, Tulu or Kodava, will have to undergo a Kannada language test, to establish their ability to speak, read and write Kannada. The Kannada Language test will be conducted by KEA as per the above schedule at Bidar, Belagavi, Ballary, Bijapura, Mangalore, Bengaluru Centres; therefore such candidates will have to appear for the 'Common Entrance Test - 2023' in a test centre located at Bengaluru, Bidar, Belagavi, Ballary, Bijapura, Mangalore Centres Only. The relevant photocopy of the original documents of the parents in support of their claim such as marks cards, study certificates, etc., along with the CET admission ticket should be produced on the day of Kannada Language Test.

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- The minimum passing marks for all Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates shall be 12 out of 50 marks in Kannada Language Examination conducted by KEA in order to be considered for assignment of ranks and to become eligible for allotment of seats in CET-2023. (The Kannada Language Test paper will be of 4<sup>th</sup> Standard Level)
- However, the Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates (including clause 'n') who have studied TEN full academic years in Kannada Medium from 1st standard to 10th standard in places outside the state of Karnataka need not appear for Kannada Language Test conducted by KEA.

# Minimum of 50% marks in Practical Examination is required to claim seat under Agriculturist Quota. Further, Agriculturist Quota is applicable only for Under Graduate courses detailed in 3 and 4 below. Practical Examination will be conducted at Bangalore, Hassan, Mandya, Raichur, Mysore, Munirabad (Koppal District), Arabhavai (Gokak Tq) Tamaka (Kolar District), Mangalore, Bidar, Bagalkot, Dharwad, Vijayapura, Hiriyur (Chitradurga) and Shimoga by concerned Agricultural / Veterinary Universities.

Practical Test Fees: Rs.500/- for General and OBC (Rs.250/- for SC, ST and Category -1), this fee amount shall be paid at the respective Practical Test Centre on the day of verification of documents in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Comptroller of the respective University.

In the case of Agriculturist Quota, the merit list will be prepared based on 25% marks each, secured in concerned combinations in II year PUC (PCMB) & CET and 50% marks secured in the Practical Test. In case of B.V.Sc & AH merit will be prepared based on 50% of Marks secured in CET (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and 50% of marks scored in the practical test.

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# 6. ELIGIBILITY CLAUSES AS PER RULE 5 (1) OF CET-2006 ADMISSION RULES TO CLAIM FOR GOVERNMENT SEATS

- 6.1 No candidate shall be eligible for admission to Government Seats unless he is a Citizen of India and satisfies any one of the following conditions.
- 6.2 Each condition is specified as a clause and is individually referred by a code. The documents to be produced during verification of documents in support of the claim for each of the Clauses are also detailed below the respective clauses.
- 6.3 The candidates who do not satisfy any of the Clauses / Eligibility Criteria detailed below and the candidates who do not produce the prescribed documents in original will not be eligible for admission to professional courses under Government quota seats.
- 6.4 Other than the certificate mentioned in clauses, if a candidate claiming seat under Article 371 (j) Hyderabad-Karnataka region reservation, candidate should produce eligibility certificate from the concerned Assistant Commissioner in Annexure-A as per the format.
- 6.5 In case, if any of the documents uploaded / produced in respect of the Clause claimed by the candidate is found to be false / incorrect, the seat allotted to the candidate will be cancelled at any stage and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate will be forfeited.
- 6.6 All the eligible candidates including General Merit, whose annual income is less than Rs.8.00 Lakhs, should obtain income certificate from the concerned Tahasildar and enter the RD number of the income certificate to become eligible for Supernumerary Quota (SNQ).

In case of the candidate who had taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only.

The candidate and either of the parent's mother tongue should be Kannada, Tulu or Kodava and either of parent was domiciled in the state of Karnataka, such candidate should have passed the qualifying examination from a University or Board or any other Institution located outside Karnataka and should be residing outside the State of Karnataka as on 1st May of 2023. Provided that the candidate shall undergo a Kannada Language test conducted by KEA.

Provided that the candidate shall undergo a Kannada Language test conducted by KEA.

Further, the candidate should have passed the Q. E. from a University or Board or any other institution located anywhere in India.

Further, the candidate should have passed the Q. E. from a University or Board or any other institution located anywhere in India.

Son or daughter of a working or retired employee of the Union Government or employee of Union or Karnataka State Government undertaking or Joint Sector undertaking where such employee;

Son or daughter of Jammu & Kashmiri migrants, proof of such migration (IDENTITY CARD) should be obtained and produced from the jurisdictional "District Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner" of any state in India.

#### Documents to be produced:

- 1) SSLC / 10th standard Marks Card of the candidate
- 2) 2nd PUC / 12th standard Marks Card of the candidate along with
- 3) A original certificate (IDENTITY CARD) issued by the Jurisdictional District Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner of any state in India, as the proof of migration. The candidates who are claiming eligibility under clause 'm' are eligible only for the seats earmarked by the Government.

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#### Clause-n

The candidates who have studied TEN full academic years in Kannada Medium from 1st standard to 10th standard in places outside the state of Karnataka and should have studied and passed the qualifying examination from any Government or Government recognised educational institution. Provided such candidates need not appear for Kannada Language Test conducted by KEA.

#### Documents to be produced:

- 1) SSLC / 10th standard Marks Card of the candidate
- 2) 2nd PUC / 12th standard Marks Card of the candidate along with –
- 3) A domicile certificate issued by the concerned Revenue or Municipal Authorities certifying that the candidate and his father / mother have resided outside the state of Karnataka as on 01-05-2023. The place of the Issuing authority should correspond to the place of domicile of the candidate / father / mother.
- 4) Candidate's Study certificate, for having studied in Kannada Medium from 1st standard to 10th standard issued by the head of the institution and countersigned by BEO.

#### Clause-o

Son / Daughter of working or Retired employee in Central Armed Police Force service, who at the time of joining the CAPF service (Central Armed Police Force) had declared the hometown as a place in the State of Karnataka, proof of such domicile having been produced by obtaining the extract from the Record Office of the CAPF Unit where the Parent's service record are maintained. Further, the candidate should have passed the Q. E. from a University or Board or any other institution located anywhere in India.

#### Documents to be produced:

- 1) SSLC / 10th standard Marks Card of the candidate
- 2) 2nd PUC / 12th standard Marks Card of the candidate;
- 3) If claiming reservation benefits: Caste / Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC / ST in Form-'D', Category-I in Form 'E' and 2A, 2B, 3A & 3B in Form 'F', Caste Certificate or Caste Income Certificate or Income Certificate should be in the name of the candidate only; along with,
- 4) Parent's home town declaration certificates while joining the service issued by Record Office of the CAPF unit, where the parent's service records are maintained.

NOTE: The SC, ST, Category-I, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B eligibility criteria is applicable to candidates who are claiming eligibility for Government seats under clauses (a), (b), (f), (h), (j), (k) (l) and (o) and the same is not applicable to clauses (c), (d), (e), (g), (i), (m) and (n) of Item - 6 i.e., Eligibility Clauses to claim Government Seats as per proviso of rule 9 (2) of CET-2006 Admission Rules.

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#### 7. NATA FOR ADMISSION TO ARCHITECTURE

For admission to Architecture course candidate should compulsorily qualify in NATA-2023 (National Aptitude Test in Architecture). The eligibility conditions as stipulated by Council of Architecture, New Delhi will apply. (Visit COA or NATA Website for more details.)

Further the candidates must compulsorily register for CET-2023, fill the application through online and pay the application fees.

Furthermore the candidates should enter and upload the NATA score card to the KEA web-portal on the specified dates.

# 8. ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY AS PER RULE 3 OF CET-2006 ADMISSION RULES - WHO CAN APPLY?

- (i) No candidate shall be eligible for admission to Government Seats unless he is a citizen of India.
- (ii) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination other than the universities listed in the notification at VTU Website are NOT eligible and candidates who have passed from Karnataka State Open University (KSOU) are also NOT eligible.
- (iii) A candidate who is expecting the qualifying examination results, (i.e., 2nd PUC / 12th Standard in 2023), may apply and appear for Common Entrance Test 2023 but he/she shall not be eligible for admission to any of the course specified in 1 above, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks.
- (iv) The educational qualifications / eligibility criteria prescribed by the Competent Authority in regulations / guidelines issued from time to time will be applicable in deciding the eligibility.
- (v) Eligibility / admissions / allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to approval by NMC / DCI / AICTE / COA / CCIM / Government / concerned University / Apex Bodies / etc.

NOTE: Merit of the candidates who have passed qualifying examination during 2021, will be determined as per the orders passed by the Hon'ble High court in WA No. 900/2022.

E. with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects and English as one of the languages of study and obtained an aggregate minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects in the Q. E. is eligible for admission to Naturopathy & Yoga courses. 40% of marks in Q. E. in case of SC, ST, Category—I and OBC (2A, 2B, 3A and 3B) Category candidates.

c) For admission to B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons) Sericulture, B.Sc (Hons) Horticulture, B.Sc (Hons) Forestry, B.Tech. Biotechnology, B.Sc. (Hons) Community Science, B.Tech (Agri. Engg), B.Tech (Food Technology), B.Tech (Dairy Technology), B.F.Sc. (Fisheries), B.Sc. (Hons) Ag. Business Management, candidates who have passed the Q. E. with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology as optional subjects are eligible.

Based on the performance of the candidates in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology subjects in both Common Entrance Test and the Qualifying Examination by taking the marks in equal proportions, common rank list will be prepared and published for the above courses.

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d) For admission to Bachelor of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry course candidates who have obtained an aggregate minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English subjects in Qualifying Examination are eligible. (40% for SC, ST, Cat-1, 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B category candidates)

Based on the performance of the candidates in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects in the Common Entrance Test, the B.V.Sc. & A.H. rank list will be prepared and published for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. courses.

e) For admission to B-Pharma candidates should have passed 2nd PUC / 12thStd in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Physics Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM /PCB) with minimum 45% marks in aggregate for GM candidates, 40% for SC/ST, Category-I and OBC or passed Diploma in Pharmacy examination from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy act and has secured a minimum of 45% of marks for GM candidates (40% for SC/ST, Category-I and OBC (2A, 2B, 3A and 3B)candidates).

Merit will be determined on the basis of performance of the candidates in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects or Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects i.e., PCB or PCM marks whichever is highest in Common Entrance Test 2023. Common rank list will be prepared and published separately for admission to B-Pharma.

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy course seeking admission to B-Pharma should compulsorily submit their photocopy of D-Pharma (final year) Marks card on which CET number boldly written to KEA on or before 30-05-2023. Failing which Rank will not be assigned to the candidate.

f) For admission to Pharma-D: Candidates should have passed in 2nd PUC / 12th Std with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or passed in Diploma in Pharmacy examination from an Institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

Merit will be determined on the basis of performance of the candidates in Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects or Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects i.e., PCB or PCM marks whichever is highest in the Common Entrance Test 2023. Common rank list will be prepared and published separately for admission to Pharma-D.

Further, the candidates seeking admission to B.Pharma, Pharma-d and Naturopathy & Yoga courses, should have completed the age of Seventeen Years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December of 2023.

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy course seeking admission to Pharma-D should compulsorily submit their photocopy of D-Pharma (final year) Marks card on which CET number boldly written to KEA on or before 30-05-2023, failing which Rank will not be assigned to the candidate.

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy course seeking admission to 2nd year B-Pharma (Lateral Entry) should compulsorily submit their photocopy of D-Pharma (final year) Marks card on which CET number boldly written to KEA on or before 30-05-2023. Failing which Rank will not be assigned to the candidate.

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IMPORTANT: IF the qualifying marks change due to any reason after verification of documents or allotment of a seat, and candidate becomes ineligible due to change of qualifying marks, it is the responsibility of candidate to inform KEA authority for withdrawal of rank or cancellation of rank or for cancellation of a seat allotted if any. Neither KEA nor Government will take the responsibility if the candidature or seat is rejected by any University / Competent Authority due to non-eligibility for a particular course in the future. Further, the seat allotment made by KEA shall be subject to approval by the concerned University / Competent Authority.

NOTE: Merit of the candidates who have passed qualifying examination during 2021, will be determined as per the orders passed by the Hon'ble High court in WA No. 900/2022.

#### NOTE:

- Candidates who do not pass in all the subjects in the qualifying examination and candidates who
  do not possess the academic eligibility detailed above for various Professional Courses, will not
  be eligible to be considered for allotment of seats in the respective courses.
- A candidate who passes in all the subjects in the qualifying examination and later withdraws one
  or more subject for reappearing in the qualifying examination for improving his performance will
  also not be considered for allotment of seats in the regular round and will be treated as a
  supplementary candidate.
- Not only a candidate who has passed the qualifying examination with requisite marks but also a candidate who is appearing for the Q.E. and expecting the results is eligible to apply for the Common Entrance Test 2023.
- Students appearing for Karnataka 2nd PUC Annual 2023 need not submit their Q. E. marks card to the KEA, as it will be obtained directly from the Department of PUE. However, all other students who have passed Karnataka 2<sup>ND</sup> PUC / 12<sup>th</sup> standard before 2023 and those who are appearing for 2023 annual 12th standard examination (such as CBSE, CISCE, 10+2, from other boards, including J & K) in 2023 should enter the marks details through online in the KEA Web-portal or must COMPULSORILY send a photocopy of their 12th standard marks card by mentioning their CET Number to KEA. Repeater students of Karnataka 2nd PU also should submit their photocopy of the marks card immediately after the exam before 30-05-2023. Otherwise, the results of such candidates will be withheld for want of Q. E. Marks. Intermediary ranks / Spot ranks will be assigned in respect of with-held candidates only after submission of photocopy of the Q. E. marks card.

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# 9. MORE ABOUT THE WRITTEN TEST - METHOD OF CET-2023

#### (i). SYLLABUS

The question papers of the Common Entrance Test will be based on the First and Second PUC syllabi prescribed by the Department of Pre-University Education of Karnataka State.

#### (ii). DURATION, QUESTION PAPER AND OMR ANSWER SHEETS

The Common Entrance Test will be held on TWO days in FOUR different sessions for four subjects. On the first day, test will be conducted for Biology and Mathematics subjects in two sessions and on the next day test will be conducted for Physics and Chemistry subjects in two sessions as per the date and time notified. Each paper / subject will be conducted for 60 marks each with duration of 80 minutes.

Each question paper will be of Multiple Choice Questions (Objective) type. The question paper in each subject will have different versions and each question will have four different options. Each question will carry ONE mark. The candidate is expected to attempt all the questions, in order to obtain maximum marks. In other words, there is no choice of questions. THERE WILL BE NO NEGATIVE EVALUATION WITH REGARD TO WRONG / INCORRECT ANSWERS BUT MARKS WILL NOT BE AWARDED IN RESPECT OF MULTIPLE ANSWERS for the same question. The version code of the question paper will be boldly printed on facing sheet of the question paper.

The version code of the question papers given to a student may be different OR may be the same for different sessions.

## (III). OPTICAL MARK READER SHEETS AS ANSWER SHEETS

A model of the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheets that will be used for marking the answers by the candidates is hosted on the KEA Website. The need for the replica has compelled us to design OMR sheet in such a way that all the information and the answers are marked only on one side. The top portion of the sheet is meant for furnishing the particulars about the candidates such as the Name, CET Number, Version code and serial number of the question booklet. The bottom portion is meant for marking the answers, affixing the signature of the room Invigilator & candidates and also for affixing the Left Hand Thumb Impression of the candidate. The space meant for the subject would have been pre-marked. The square blocks in each item should be filled by the candidate in capital letters and numbers. The circles corresponding to the letters or numbers are meant to be completely shaded using blue or black ink ballpoint pen only.

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#### (B) NEXT 70 MINUTES:

Important precautions to be taken while shading answers on bottom portion of OMR Answer sheet.

After the initial TEN minutes, 70 minutes will be given to a candidate for shading the answers on the bottom portion of the OMR answer sheet. On the bottom portion, there will be 60 rows corresponding to 60 questions. Against each question number, four circles will be provided corresponding to four options of the question paper. The candidates are required to shade only one circle corresponding to the correct answer.

The scanner is so sensitive to black and blue ink shades that even a slight residual ink mark or an unintended ink dot within a circle on the OMR answer sheet will be taken by it, as filled / shaded, at the time of scanning. Consequently, the candidate may lose marks. Therefore, please do not make any stray pen marks on the OMR answer sheets. As the scoring done by the scanner and the computer in tandem is final, a plea for erasing or neglecting the ink mark on a circle cannot be entertained. Therefore, candidates are advised to take extra precaution while shading the circles on the bottom portion.

#### (C) END OF PAPER FOR EACH SESSION:

The candidates are required to COMPULSORILY AFFIX THEIR LEFT HAND THUMB IMPRESSION in the space provided on the bottom portion of the OMR answer sheet of the upper with the ink-pad provided by the room Invigilator, after completion of each Session of the Test. However, they need not affix their thumb impression on the lower sheet i.e., the replica of the OMR answer sheet. Thereafter, the invigilators will detach the lower sheet from the upper sheet at the perforations and hand over the lower sheet replica to the candidates and candidates are allowed to carry the same with them. The upper sheet will be retained by the invigilator for returning the same to the Deputy Chief Superintendent of the examination center and in turn to KEA.

**NOTE:** The OMR answer sheets in respect of all the candidates who have affixed their left hand thumb impression will only be scanned and the results in respect of such candidates will be published. The OMR answer sheets in respect of candidates who have not affixed their left hand thumb impression, for any reason, will not be scanned. Also, the results in respect of such candidates will not be published.

#### THINK BEFORE YOU INK!

Once you darken a circle, there is no way to erase or to remove it. That way, your decision about a correct answer will be final. The invigilator will not permit to use marker, white fluid or any other devise to hide the shading already done and you will not be supplied with one more set of OMR sheet. If you spoil a sheet in your attempt to rub off the shading done on a you may ruin your opportunities. If two circles are shaded in a row and even if one of the circles is partially rubbed off, the scanner will take it as a multiple attempt. Therefore, think twice before you shade a circle with ink. Darken only one circle for each question as shown against the CORRECT METHOD.

Provided that where merit of two or more candidates is same, the interse merit shall be determined with reference to the marks obtained in the Aptitude test; where marks obtained in 1[National Aptitude Test for Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture]1 are equal, then the interse merit shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in Mathematics in the qualifying examination and where marks obtained in Mathematics are equal, the interse merit shall be determined on the basis of the age of the candidate, the elder candidate placed above the younger.

**NOTE:** If everything as specified in the provisions to sub-clauses referred to above i.e. (A) 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 are equal, then the interse merit will be determined by draw of lots. The determination of interse merit as detailed above for selection of Government seats will be the basis for the merit list of candidates claiming benefit of reservation under Admission Rules.

#### (B) PUBLICATION OF MERIT LISTS:

After the completion of the entrance test, the Provisional ANSWER KEY will be published on the dates notified by KEA on the KEA Website: <a href="http://kea.kar.nic.in">http://kea.kar.nic.in</a> The candidates / parents / lecturers can file their objections, if any, only through online, with regard to any of the published answer Key, along with all supporting documents / justification. The objections received by the KEA will be placed before an Expert Committee, whose decision will be final for determination of the right answer key. The answer key approved by the Expert Committee will be applied during evaluation for determination of merit order.

As per the merit determined by the KEA, Engineering, Architecture, Farm Science, B-Pharm and Pharm-D ranks will be assigned to the eligible candidates. Separate result sheets showing the Engineering, Architecture, Farm science, B-Pharm and Pharm-D ranks will be published on the notified date on KEA Website <a href="http://kea.kar.nic.in">http://kea.kar.nic.in</a>. The correct answer key and the list of candidates whose results have been withheld and the reasons for withholding the results will also be published along with the results. The candidates whose results are with-held for want of 2nd PUC / 12th std. Marks and date of birth such candidates / parents need not worry because, ranks will be assigned as and when they submit the required documents on the specified dates during office hours.

Result sheets will not be displayed in the KEA premises.

Candidates who have any objections in respect of any of the entries or issues or discrepancies in the result sheets, such as discrepancy / changes in the Q. E. marks, version code, NEET / NATA scores etc., except the marks secured in the Common Entrance Test, can submit their objections within three days from the date of publication of the CET - 2023 result and thereafter result will be published for such candidates. (See box item given below for details about intermediary ranks / Spot ranks i.e., ranks ending with G55, G44, G33 etc.)

NOTE: (1) The candidates are requested to verify their qualifying examination details displayed on the result sheets without fail, if there is any discrepancy with reference to qualifying examination marks the same should be brought to the notice of this office immediately for fresh assignment of ranks, if any.

- (2) Candidates whose results will be withheld for want of qualifying examination marks should submit a photocopy of their Q. E. marks card either in person or through 'Speed Post' to the KEA and the ranks in respect of such candidates will be published subsequently.
- (C) Request for re-totaling or revaluation of the OMR answer sheets will not be entertained, as the valuation and the subsequent scoring will be error free.

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#### What does 'G 55' mean?

After the declaration of the results, the candidates may not get ranks assigned mainly for the following reasons :

- (1) For want of Q. E. marks, a candidate might have missed the rank.
- (2) A candidate might have marked the version code wrongly.
- (3) Q. E. marks may change due to revaluation or otherwise, when corrected, a fresh ranking becomes necessary.

The KEA computers are programmed to assign new ranks or fresh ranks to the candidates falling within the above said categories without disturbing the rank numbers assigned to the candidates whose results were declared earlier. The computer program is such that it can assign ranks in between two integers without altering the previous rank numbers. Undoubtedly, you were assigned a rank after the declaration of the results. When a rank was assigned to you, rank 1234 and 1235 had been assigned to two other candidates. When it came to assigning a rank to you, the computer found that in the normal course, your rank would have been after the candidate with rank 1234 and before the candidate with rank 1235. Therefore, the computer had to place you between 1234 and 1235. As already said, the computer is programmed to generate large number of ranks between two integers by dividing the space alphabetically from A to Z. Then each alphabet is subdivided from 1 to 99. Now, if a new rank is required to be assigned between two integer ranks, in the first instance, the computer assigns a division number as 'G 55' before the previous rank. If one more rank needs to be assigned between the rank 1234 and 1234 G 55, the computer assigns a rank as 1234 G 44. If one more rank is to be assigned between 1234 G 55 and 1235, then it assigns a rank as 1234 G 66.

Based on the performance of the candidates in the Common Entrance Test / NATA and the Qualifying Examination, as the case may be, the merit / rank list will be prepared and published. All the eligible candidates will be considered for allotment of seats in the order of their merit / rank and based on the options and as per the seat matrix issued by the Government.

The interse merit determined under Rule - 7 (Please see Item - 6) will remain the same for the purpose of eligibility and benefit of reservation under Item - 7. (f)	Reservation for PHYSICALLY DISABLED:	became permanently disabled or were killed during hostilities.  The candidates claiming reservation under this category will be required to appear for Medical examination before a Committee comprising of the Executive Director, KEA as Chairman and three specialists from the Department of Orthopedics, Ophthalmology and ENT, nominated by the Government. Candidates with physical disability ranging above 40% should produce a Medical certificate issued by competent Doctor of any Government Hospital located in the State of Karnataka in the field of concerned disability, only on the day of Medical examination. shall have the same meaning assigned to it, in the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Participation) Act 1995 (Central Act 1 / 1995) and subject to "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act - 2016". The candidates with disability less than 40% will not be eligible for claiming a seat under Physically Disabled category. The candidates claiming under Physically Disabled Special category quota should appear for medical examination only at KEA Office in BANGALORE.

NOTE: The Physically Disabled candidates, who fail to appear before the Committee

**NOTE:** The Physically Disabled candidates, who fail to appear before the Committee for Medical examination, will not be eligible to be considered for allotment of seat under Physically Disabled category.

(g) Reservation for ANGLO-INDIAN: be allowed for claiming under A

Candidates from Anglo-Indian Community certificate issued by the Registered Association of the Anglo Indian Community in the State of Karnataka countersigned by the Anglo-Indian MLA Nominated by the Government, failing which they will not be allowed for the later allotment of seats under Anglo-Indian. The candidates claiming under Anglo Indian Special category quota should submit their documents only at KEA Office in BANGALORE.

Reservation for CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCE:-

Candidates claiming eligibility under Clause (o) of Item – 6 of Chapter I of e-brochure should produce a certificate from the Record Office of the CAPF Unit in the prescribed format appended to this brochure indicating that the parent had declared a place in Karnataka as his hometown at the time of joining the service.

Reservation for Ex-(i) CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCE:- Candidates claiming eligibility under Clause (o) of Item -6 of Chapter I of e-brochure should produce a certificate from the Record Office of the CAPF Unit in the prescribed format appended to this brochure indicating that the parent had declared a place in Karnataka as his hometown at the time of joining the service.

NOTE: Candidates belonging to Scouts & Guides, Defence, Ex-defence and Anglo-Indian, CAPF, Ex-CAPF i. e., subclauses (c), (d), (e).(g), (h) and (i) above, will be considered for allotment of seats in the respective special category seats as per their merit order ONLY in the General Round of allotment of seats along with the other general merit and reserved category candidates

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# 13. ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS TO BE KEPT READY

Procedure and process of verification of documents will be notified later in the KEA Website. For the benefit of the candidates, the documents which are required for verification are detailed below.

- Online seat allotment for admission to various Professional Courses for the year 2023, will be based on the claims made by the candidates in their online application form and supporting documents / certificates produced by the eligible candidates.
- Hence, candidates are advised to be ready with all the necessary certificates / documents for verification as per their claims made in the online application to claim eligibility and reservation benefits.
- The candidate should possess all necessary original documents with them in support of their claim made in the online application. If any candidate fails to produce any of the documents / certificates / marks card, such candidate will not get eligibility to exercise the options for seat allotment.

Eg:

- If a candidate claims 3A caste category reservation in the online application and fails to obtain & produce the Caste cum Income Certificate issued by the concerned Tahasildar, then he / she will not be eligible to claim 3A reservation.
- If a candidate mentioned as 'YES' for Rural reservation in the online application, but fails to produce the Rural Study Certificate for having studied 1 to 10<sup>th</sup> standard in the rural areas issued by the Competent Authority, then such candidate will not be eligible to claim Rural Reservation.
- Likewise, submission of relevant certificate / documents is mandatory to claim any reservation benefits; candidates will become ineligible to be considered under that particular reservation due to non-submission of the relevant certificates / documents.
- Even though a candidate is eligible to claim Rural Reservation, but he / she has not claimed in the online application then he / she will not be eligible to claim such reservation. Furthermore, candidates will not be eligible for any type of reservation if it is not claimed in the online application.

#### NOTE:

- Study Certificate should contain the details about study period and years. BEO / DDPU counter Signature is compulsory on the study certificate.
- Check the date of issue of Caste / Caste Income Certificate. Check the validity of the Caste / Caste Income Certificate.
- Caste Certificate or Caste Income Certificate or Income Certificate should be in the name of the candidate only.
- Caste / Caste Income Certificate of Karnataka State only. OBC certificate issued by Central Government is not valid for admissions through KEA; it should be in Form-F for 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B reservations, Form-E for Category-1 and Form-D for SC / ST reservations.
- Category-1 and SC or ST candidate should also submit income certificate to avail the benefit of
  fee exemption as per Government norms. IF they fail to produce the income certificate they will
  not be eligible to claim fee exemption benefit.
- Further the candidate shall be eligible to claim caste, category and income benefit only if he has claimed the same in the CET-2023 online application form.

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#### ## MEDICAL / DENTAL courses

Those who are appearing for UGNEET-2023 may please note that the documents which they are furnishing for Engineering etc courses will also be considered for Medical / Dental / AYUSH courses if they become eligible in UGNEET-2023. Further, candidates claiming additional reservations like Linguistic Minority / Religious Minority / NRI ward for Medical and Dental courses and admission to St. Johns Medical College, may keep the Linguistic Minority / Religious Minority / NRI ward certificates ready. The details will be hosted on the KEA Website separately.

The Linguistic Minority, Religious Minority and NRI Ward reservations are not applicable for Engineering, Architecture, Veterinary, Farm Science, B-Pharma, Pharma-D, AYUSH courses.

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# ANNEXURE-II to G.O. No. SWD 225 BCA 2000 dated 30<sup>th</sup> March 2002

#### NEW COMPREHENSIVE CREAMY LAYER

Under Article 15(4) and 16(4) of the Constitution of India, the following persons shall not be eligible for reservation of seats of posts categorised under IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB.

- 1. This rule will not apply to direct recruitments to posts-which insist on a prescribed period of service in a lower post or experience in a post, profession or occupation as a qualification or
- 2. This rule applies to son(s) or daughter(s) of the persons specified below:
- (a) President of India
- (b) Vice President of India
- (c) All functionaries holding Cabinet rank in Government of India or Government of any State or Union
- (d) Chairmen of Council of States and the State Legislative Councils.
- (e) Governor of States.
- (f) Speakers of Lok Sabha and Legislative Assemblies.
- (g) Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts.
  - (h) Chairmen of Public Service Commission.
  - (i) Attorney General of India.
  - (j) Advocate General.
  - (k) Chief Election Commissioner.
  - (I) Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
  - (m) Members of Parliament atleast for a period of five years during the period of their office.
  - (n) Members of State Legislature atleast for a period of five years during the period of their office.
- The Candidate and either of whose parents / guardian is a Group -A or Group B officer in the services of the Government or holds an equivalent post in public sector undertakings or an employee of a private industry / institution and draws a salary which is not Less than that of a Group B officer (Pay scale Rs. 6000-

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#### 19. A NOTE ON SEAT CANCELLATION, REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEE

As per Rule 12 of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government Seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules, 2006,

- (1) If a candidate who has been allotted a seat in any discipline in the First Round or in the Second Round and who has reported to the college, wishes to surrenders / cancel the seat before the last date notified for entry of options for the Second Extended Round / Casual Vacancy Round, the Executive Director, shall deduct Rs.5,000/- as processing fee and refund the remaining fee paid.
- (2) If a candidate who has been allotted a seat in any discipline (except Engineering) in the First Round or in the Second Round and who has reported to the college or not, surrenders the seat after the completion of Second Extended Round / Casual Vacancy Round the Executive Director, shall forfeit the entire fee paid.
- (3) The candidate who surrenders the seat (except Engineering) allotted in the Second Extended Round / Casual Vacancy Round, the Executive Director shall forfeit the entire fee paid.
- (4) If a Candidate who has been allotted a seat in any discipline in an Engineering College or Institution under sub-rule (4) of rule 10 surrenders the seat after completion of respective Casual Vacancy Round, the Executive Director shall forfeit the entire fee paid and the candidate shall be liable to pay a penalty of five times of the fee.
- (5) if a candidate does not surrender the allotted a seat in any discipline in an Engineering College or Institution under sub-rule (4) of rule 10 or fail to join the allotted college even after the completion of the Casual Vacancy Round, the Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority shall forfeit the entire fee amount paid by the candidates and the candidate shall be liable to pay a penalty of five times of the fee.
- (6) If a candidate reports to the college and later on leaves the college he / she have to necessarily surrender the seat back to KEA only. It is the endeavor of KEA to see that subsidized Government Quota seats are accessible and available to all meritorious students. Hence failing to surrender the seat back to KEA will be viewed as a breach of contract and severe lack of social responsibility.
- (7) No surrender or cancellation of seat shall be accepted, unless the candidate surrenders the original admission order issued by the KEA, original Bank Challan and original Verification Slip.
- (8) If a candidate does not surrender / cancel / fails to join the allotted college (except engineering) even after the completion of the Second Extended Round / Casual Vacancy Round the Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority shall forfeit the entire fee amount paid by the candidates.


